1. A narrative or expository piece explaining why the individual or organization should receive the award. The narrative should include specific examples of how the nominee has shown courage in advancing the cause of intellectual freedom or fighting censorship. The piece should be 1-3 pages (double-spaced).
2. Please submit 1-3 items that that support the nomination. These documents may be letters of recommendation, newspaper articles, or any other items that show the nominee's commitment to intellectual freedom.

The applicant package should be **no longer than 6 pages**, excluding this award application page.
